Crimson/purple colour- very rich forward nose - tight knit and brooding. It has an iron grip of tannins and structure with a streak of sweetness to balance.

Frédérique Goulley, the nicce of Christian Sérafin, who has been working alongside her unde for over ten years now, is now very much the winemaking driving force at the domaine, while Christian slows down. Although the bation has been handed over, the wine making phisosyle central to the winemaking here. A cool ten day maceration helps create a stunning richness and concentration with the diligent use of new oak and the non-diffiction of the wines being key to the Sérafin style. They continue to destem around 70% of the bunches. The grapes are fermented at a relatively high temperature and enjoy up to 100% new oak ageing.
